Advising Notes

1. A grade of C or higher in all required coursework is necessary for major completion; all courses must be taken for a letter grade, except in courses which are designated CR/NC grading only.
2. Nursing additional major requirements must be completed **by the time of graduation**; BSN additional major requirements may be double counted for general education requirements.
3. All practicum courses (w/ suffix “AL” or “L”) require a minimum of three hours of clinical work per unit of credit as a minimum to meet course objectives.
