Kin-GAP	Yes, if youth entered Kin-GAP at 16 or older	Yes, if youth entered Kin-GAP prior to age 16	Yes, regardless of the age the youth entered Kin-GAP
AAP	Yes, if youth entered AAP at 16 or older	No	Yes, regardless of the age the youth entered AAP
CalWORKs	Yes, if youth is a dependent in out of home care at age 18	Yes	No, unless further legislation is passed
