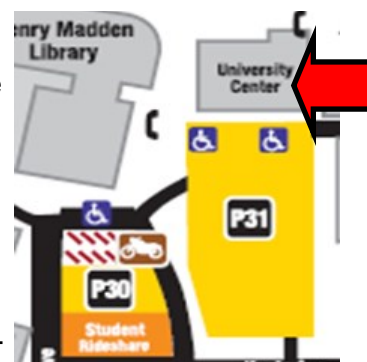
Directions

Vintage Room, California State University, Fresno

Coming from the north: Take Hwy 99 south to the Hwy 180 east exit. On Hwy 180 east, exit east on Hwy 168. On Hwy 168 east, exit on Shaw Avenue. Turn left (west) on Shaw Avenue to Barton Avenue. Turn right on Barton Avenue and then left on Keats Avenue. Parking lots P30 and P31 will be on your left (parking is free just do not park in any signed spaces). The Vintage Room is located on the northeast corner of P31 on the east side of the University Center (see red arrow).

Coming from the south: Take Hwy 99 to the Hwy 41 north exit. On Hwy 41 north, exit east on Hwy 180. On Hwy 180 east, exit east on Hwy 168. On Hwy 168 east, exit on Shaw Avenue. Turn left (west) on Shaw Avenue to Barton Avenue. Turn right on Barton Avenue and then left on Keats Avenue. Parking lots P30 and P31 will be on your left (parking is free just do not park in any signed spaces). The Vintage Room is located on the northeast corner of P31 on the east side of the University Center (see red arrow).
